Student Travel to Sport Requirements.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

It is timely that we remind all students and parents of our school expectations regarding student travel to sport. Recently, a few of our senior students have behaved inappropriately while driving to sport in their own private vehicles.

The Homebush Boys High School Sports Policy 2017 clearly states that "walking/public transport/organised school bus are the **ONLY** forms of transport to and from sport. Students are **NOT to drive and/or be a passenger in their private vehicle or someone else's vehicle when travelling to and from sport**".

The HBHS Sports Policy also states that all students have a responsibility to "travel safely and directly to the sporting venue without breaking their travel, following all rules and laws of the public. This includes **NOT** leaving the school grounds during lunch time if the venue is Homebush Boys HS".

Student behaviour and travel to sport is also addressed in the School's Safety, Learning and Respect framework and in our 2017 Bushy Boys behaviours.

Failure to comply with student travel to sport requirements places students at risk and may lead to serious consequences. Students are advised to **NOT** drive to sporting venues as this places them and their passengers in danger of not meeting our sport travel expectations. This behaviour may lead to either an after school detention, removal from the sporting team or even suspension.

Additionally, our student insurance policy does not cover student drivers and their passengers for travel to and from sporting venues in private vehicles.


