Our personal development events would be highly beneficial to your students, as they include study days and skills workshops, as well as a Presentation and Science Show Training camp. At our study days, our older members, who are in university, act as mentors and help our younger members with their studies.

Furthermore, the skills workshops introduce or help students develop their skills in programs such as Microsoft Excel, Powerpoint and coding. We aim to hold these at least once every school term and they are usually held at universities or locations in Sydney's CBD.

These include workshops and stalls at museums social events, fairs and universities, as well as science shows and demonstrations.
