- Entries for Operation Art are only accepted from NSW schools
- Each school may submit up to four artworks from any student in Kindergarten - Year 10
- For collaborative works, a maximum of four students per work may contribute to creating the entry.
- Size: Minimum A4 (30 x 21cm), maximum A2 (42 x 60cm), maximum depth 5mm. Please note: we are unable to frameworks that are deeper than this limit. Please do not laminate works. Please do not use Blue tac on works.
