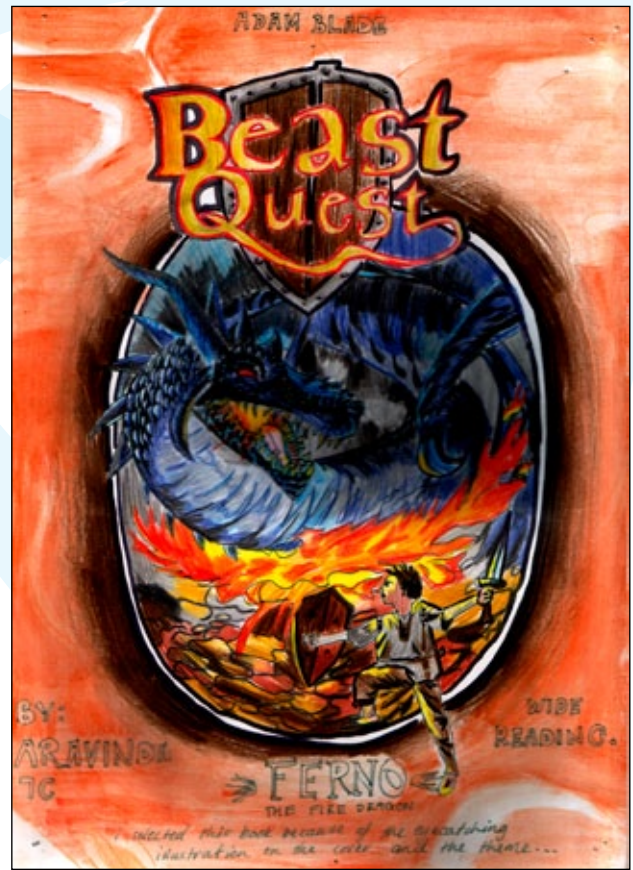

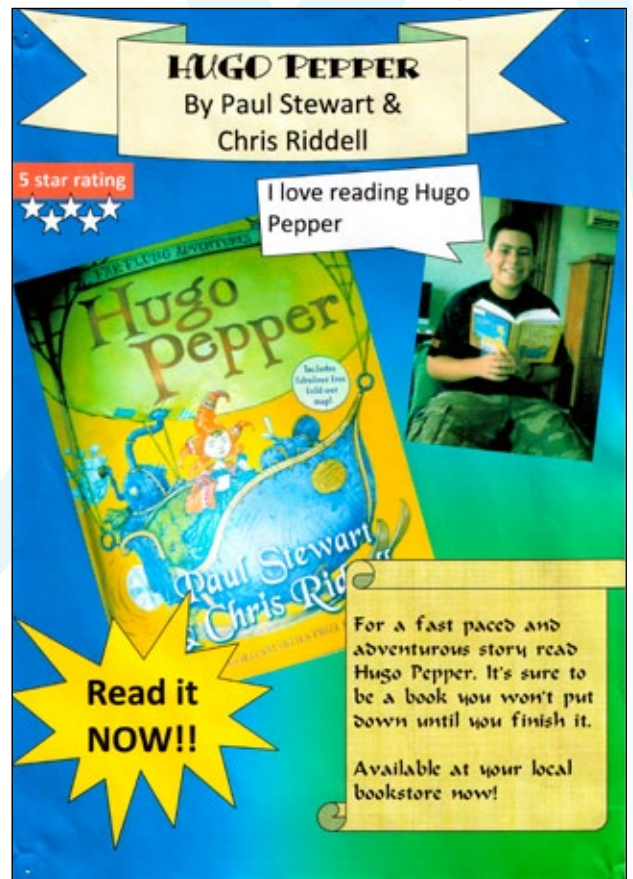

After a strong performance throughout the regular season Homebush finished 2nd to undefeated and reigning premiers Asquith. An unexpected loss to Epping in the 2nd last round was reversed in the Semi Final, Homebush winning a tight one 5-4 and qualifying for the Grand Final. The competition had 3 quality sides whilst against some other opponents we were able to rack up some big wins such as 21-1, 17-4 and 17-5 all in the space of two 20 minute halves.

Although not having beaten Asquith for 2 seasons, the boys knew the potential was there and were confident they could produce their best on the day. Joint Captains Yousef Morgan and Hassan Koussan had been the playmakers all season. Out wider we had the vision and creativity of Cameron Parcell, Dylan Kang and Andrew Suamili, and the speed and evasion of Tamer Soufy, Dylan Fuller, Mohammad Sartawy, Brandon Vuong, Aaron Ilohahia and Tevita Moeakiola. Providing impact with ball play and hard running were Anthony Phan, Brian Dowling, Lachlan Mackintosh, Scott Tolhurst, William Dowsley, Lucas Chao and Yousef Sarakbi.

The Final started well and we soon led 2-0 after 10 minutes. Asquith played on without fear and soon hit back with 4 tries in succession to lead 4-2 at half time. Yousef and Hassan's quick thinking and agility was creating space for the outside men sending Brandon, Dylan and Anthony into space, while Cameron and Andrew were directing play well. Soon we were all tied up at 4-4 with 10 minutes to go. Asquith then followed up with 2 tries and with 5 minutes to go we needed something special. Homebush responded with tries to Hassan and Aaron to level up with 1 minute remaining and the game was sent into extra time.

Three minutes into extra time, and with Homebush having the better of play we received a penalty. We had 6 tackles to break a 7 man line following the extra time player drop off system, there was plenty of space but also a lot of tired and stressed bodies. After threatening on plays 1 and 2 Hassan split the line and crossed the try line. After a quick confirmation from the referee regarding the extra time laws the boys knew the title was theirs and celebrated a great game by all.

Summer Sport

The 2009-2010 Summer Sports Season reached its conclusion with Homebush once again performing extremely well in the North West Metropolitan Zone Competition which is comprised of seven boys high schools (Ashfield, Asquith, Epping, Homebush, Normanhurst, North Sydney & Randwick). We won the Champion Summer School Trophy.

We entered thirty teams in eight different sports (baseball, basketball, cricket, futsal (indoor soccer), oz tag, tennis, volleyball & water polo).

We made it into 26 semi-finals (only missed out on 4) and we contested 16 finals of which we were victorious in 8. The Premiership winning teams were: 14B Cricket, Junior Futsal, Junior Oz Tag, 15's Tennis, 1st & 15's Volleyball & 1st & 15's Water Polo.

We were Minor Premiers in 2nd Grade Cricket, 14A Cricket, Junior Futsal (Indoor Soccer), 15's Tennis, 1st, 15's & 14's Volleyball, and 1st & 15's Water Polo.

As well as winning the Champion Summer School Trophy for the 3rd consecutive year, we were named Champion School in Cricket, Futsal (Indoor Soccer), Volleyball & Water Polo.

Winter Sport

Winter Sport trials commenced on March 10th and will conclude on the 31st of March.

Our intention is to nominate 3 badminton teams (15's, 1st & 2nd Grade), 4 hockey teams (2 juniors & 2 seniors), 2 lawn bowls teams (junior & senior), 6 rugby union teams (13A & 13B, 14's, 15's, 1st & 2nd Grade), 11 football (soccer) teams (13A, B & C, 14A & B, 15A & B, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th Grade), 4 table tennis teams (14's, 15's, 1st & 2nd Grade), and 4 tennis teams (14's, 15's, 1st & 2nd Grade).

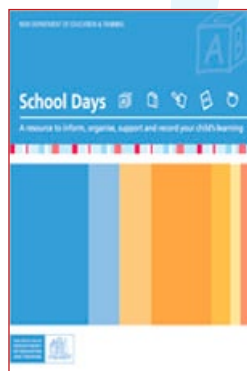
The Winter Sport season will commence on April 21st and will finish on July 28th.
